Morris, Jr., a descendant of Frederick Douglass *and* Booker T. Washington! He is one of four featured speakers at Day 1 of our conference. Staff are also invited to his presentation!

The title of his talk: *History, Human Rights, and the Power of One*

Description:

Take a living history journey with a direct descendant of two of America's most influential heroes. Kenneth B. Morris, Jr. is the great great-great-grandson of Frederick Douglass and the great-great-grandson of Booker T. Washington. Ken will give a dynamic presentation about the history of his famous family, the pressure he felt growing up in the shadow of his esteemed ancestors, and his work today fighting against modern slavery as President of Frederick Douglass Family Initiatives. He'll also talk about his organization's latest project to commemorate Douglass's Bicentennial, One Million Abolitionists.
