4. Muckrakers and Bosses (muckrakers; corruption in city government; reforming city government)

5. Fighting the Trusts (trusts; consumers and workers; laws regulating trusts; Theodore Roosevelt's role; "The Jungle," Meat Inspection Act; Pure Food and Drug Act; Forestry Act)

6. Teddy and the Professor (Roosevelt; Taft; Wilson; Election of 1912; views on trusts; Clayton Anti-Trust Act; Federal Reserve Act)

7. Freedom? Whose Freedom? (racial segregation; lynchings; Booker T. Washington; W.E.B. DuBois; socialism; IWW or “Wobblies”)

8. Women Suffragists (list arguments for suffrage, including racist and nativist ones)

9. Transition (list of things that ended progressivism; problems left to solve)
